**Closing Date:** Entries will be accepted until 5:00 PM on Thursday, December 29, 2011 after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

**Entry Fee:** \$25.00 made payable to Sacramento Dog Training Club (SDTC)

**Tracking Match Entries:** All dogs eligible to participate in AKC Tracking Tests may enter. Passing dogs will receive four tracking certification from the certifying judge. Entries are limited to 10 dogs. TDX match will give preference to dogs holding an AKC Tracking Dog Title and is limited to 5 dogs.

**The Draw:** A random drawing of all entries received by the closing time and date to determine which entries will participate in the match will take place on Thursday, December 29, 2011 at 6:00 PM, Carl's Jr. Restaurant, 8140 Sheldon Rd, Elk Grove, CA 95758

**Alternate List:** An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries which are to run.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wire-haired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

Notification: Notification of the draw results will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Match Secretary.

Refund policy: The entry fee shall be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw of such withdrawal and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

Bitches in season may participate: If you know that your bitch will be in season the day of the match, notify the match secretary ahead of time. When you arrive at the match site, park your vehicle away from the other cars and notify the match secretary that your entered bitch is in season. The last track to be laid will be reserved for those bitches in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for those bitches will be held. Bitches in season will only be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been matched. They must be kept away from the rest of the entered dogs. Failure to comply will result in the handler and dog being excused from the match site and any award withheld.

Draw for running order: All TD entrants must be at the match site by 7:00 AM the morning of the match, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

All TDX entrants must be at the match site by 10:00 am the morning of the match, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

Judging will begin as soon as tracks have sufficiently aged.

Dogs on leash: "All dogs and bitches entered in this match must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the match site and the withholding of any awards. This also applies to any non-entered dogs that may accompany anyone at this match."

Directions to match site: From Sacramento take Hwy 50 towards Placerville. Take Sunrise Blvd. South exit and go 4 miles to Douglas Rd. Turn right on Douglas Rd. and go 1 mile to Eagles Nest Rd. Turn left on Eagles Nest Rd. Go 2/10 mile and turn left into Mather Field Rotary Park where we will meet for the draw. From Placerville take Hwy 50 towards Sacramento and follow the above directions.
