- This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form
- Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
- Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- ◆ There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or handler or bitches in season and must have a note from your doctor or vet. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing prior to the trial. NEW PREMIER STANDARD AND JUMPERS CLASSES

We are offering the newest AKC Agility classes – Premier Standard and Premier JWW. These classes will provide an opportunity for agility competitors to demonstrate handling skills that may be different than those required for the Masters level classes.

Both Premier Standard and Premier JWW courses will be Master level courses incorporating a number of elements that challenge the dog and handler in ways that are not typically seen on traditional AKC courses.
