Test Worker Option - In accordance with AKC regulations, two TD tracks will be reserved for test workers who have earned required credits. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test worker is chosen. The remaining workers will automatically be included in the drawing with all other tracking entries received.

Bitches in Season may participate in the test. Handlers are asked to park well away from the other vehicles and to notify the secretary that your entered bitch is in season. They will be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. The last track will be for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, there will be a separate draw for these bitches.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to insure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccination is required in the State of California. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Test Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending the test hereby waive any claim for damages against SDTC or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
