

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

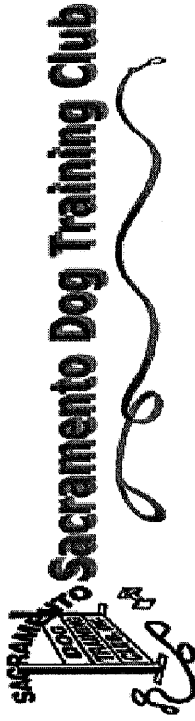
- ◆ This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILPIPAL numbers or are listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate
- ◆ Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- ◆ Running order will be determined by a random draw. Handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- ◆ There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, except for bitches in season, or in the event of injury to dog or handler as documented by a physician or vet. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified in writing, with appropriate documentation prior to the trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- ◆ No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ◆ Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry - PLEASE PRINT; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial.
- ◆ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- ◆ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ◆ All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area. Additionally, please be courteous and clean up after your dog.
- ◆ DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.
- ◆ Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- ◆ The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
- ◆ Electronic timing will be used.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Course Familiarization / Warm – ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than **6pm Monday, November 26, 2018**. Day to day move ups will be accepted providing a move up form is completed and turned into the Trial Secretary on site no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the last class of the day.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st - 4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple or Sextuple Q will be awarded a corresponding pin. Special rosette and jump bar will be awarded to any dog completing a MACH or PACH title at the trial. If you anticipate completing your MACH or PACH at our trial, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary in advance!

Assumption of Risk and Waiver

For valuable consideration and to induce permission to participate in canine activities held at Murieta Equestrian Center ("MEC"), 7200 Lone Pine Drive, Rancho Murieta, CA 95683, each of the undersigned agrees to the following terms and makes the following warranties:

I acknowledge that participating in canine activities, whether as a show participant or an audience member, is a HAZARDOUS RECREATION ACTIVITY with RISK of damage or PERSONAL INJURY, including PARALYSIS OR DEATH, to any person or property. Canines have the propensity to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around the canine; have unpredictable reactions to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; are susceptible to certain hazards such as surface or subsurface conditions, collisions with other canines or objects; propensities include kicking, biting, stamping, stumbling, rearing, and others; tack equipment can fail resulting in falling or loss of control; and activities have the potential of the participant(s) to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the canines or not acting within the participant's ability. Canine activities are INHERENTLY DANGEROUS, I understand this is not a complete description of all risks and that other unknown or unforeseeable hazards and risks of harm may occur.

With this in mind, I accept full responsibility for my own safety and EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM, whether foreseen or unforeseen while participating in canine activities at the Murieta Equestrian Center, I am physically fit and know of no medical or health reason why I should not participate in this activity.

I hereby RELEASE and agree to DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS MEC, Cosunnes Corporation, Foxfarms, Inc., their shareholders, officers, employees, agents, instructors, equipment manufacturers, lessors, and insurers (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties Released"), from and against any liability, demand, claim, or right of action for any damage or injury, including paralysis or death, to any person or property, even if such damage or personal injury results from the NEGLIGENCE of MEC or other Parties Released. I further COVENANT NOT TO SUE or make any demand or claim against MEC or other Parties Released, for or by reason of any such damage or personal injury from my participation in canine activities at MEC. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lesser of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular filling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above on this form.
