IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS:

- If you provide an email address on your entry form, all future communications will be via email, including final confirmation information and judging schedule. Please make sure the Trial Secretary's email address: (VCDK9s@comcast.net) is allowed by your spam blocker. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email address.

NOTE: ENTRIES RECEIVED WITH POSTAGE DUE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BUT WILL BE RETURNED TO SENDER WITHOUT ACTION

- There will not be equipment familiarization at this trial.
- Move ups will be accepted until **6 pm Monday, July 19, 2010**
- ENTRY FEES (PER DOG, PER DAY): \$16.00 - 1ST Class; \$16.00 – 2nd class /\$16.00 - 3rd class (includes AKC Recording Fees of \$3 for each run).
- SHOW SITE: This show will be held indoors on hard packed dirt. Ring dimensions will be 80 ' by 100'
- Each exhibitor will get **2 people credentials and 1 parking credential.**

AWARDS

- Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs with qualifying scores in each regular and preferred class and jump height. A voucher for a future SDTC agility trial will be awarded for first place.
- Green Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score.
- Special Rosettes or pins will be awarded to any dog completing a title or earning a "Double Q" or "Triple Q" from the Excellent B classes.
- Special Award for any dog completing a MACH or PACH. If you anticipate you may complete your MACH or PAX at our trial, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary by the preceding Monday.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained an ILP/PAL number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Running order will be determined by a random draw, and handlers with more than one dog will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- No hand delivery of entries within the first 24 hours after the opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope.
- **There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except in the event of injury to dog or bitches in season. In these cases, entries will be refunded (minus expenses) provided the trial secretary is notified prior to the trial.** In the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal, there shall be no refund.
- No entry fee will be refunded if this trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Exhibitors, while competing, must wear appropriate/proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to complete in "bare" feet or open toe shoes.
- Ring will be enclosed by netting
- Electronic timing will be used.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a "cash only" basis.
- **It is ESSENTIAL that you clean up after your dog.** Let's show them that "Dog People" are clean people.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES.** The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of animals in distress.
- On Call Veterinarian:
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
- **Course Familiarization/Warm-ups** Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided

AGILITY TRIAL SITE AND ACCOMONDATIONS

SITE: Cal Expo 1600 Exposition Blvd Sacramento, CA 95815

This Trial will be held indoors on **HARD PACKED DIRT** with metal railing AND netting separating the ring from the spectators. There will also be baby gates around any floral displays. Cattle may be shown in the same ring earlier in the day or week.

DIRECTIONS:

Northbound

Northbound drivers to Sacramento can take either Interstate 5 or Highway 99. From I-5, take the Capital City Freeway East exit from Downtown Sacramento, follow the signs to Reno. The Cal Expo exit is just Northeast of the American River. Highway 99 becomes the Capital City Freeway just North of the 12th Avenue exit. Continue over the river to Cal Expo.

Southbound

Southbound drivers to Sacramento can arrive via Interstate 5, Highway 99 or Highway 70. Highways 99 and 70 join I-5 just North of Sacramento. From I-5, take the I-80/Reno exit East and continue to the Capital City Freeway exit just past Watt Avenue. Continue toward downtown Sacramento until you reach the Cal Expo exit.

Eastbound

Eastbound travelers to Sacramento should take Interstate 80 to Sacramento, taking the Capital City Freeway exit in West Sacramento (following the signs to Lake Tahoe). Continue on Capital City Freeway, through downtown Sacramento and make the turnoff to Reno. The Cal Expo exit is just Northeast of the American River.

Westbound

Westbound travelers can take Interstate 80 or Highway 50 to Sacramento. From I-80, take the Capital City Freeway exit to Downtown Sacramento just beyond Madison Avenue. Continue to the Cal Expo exit. From Highway 50, take the Reno turnoff just past Stockton Boulevard to the Cal Expo exit just Northeast of the river.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: REGULAR TITLING CLASS

Novice A – For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an AKC agility title.

Novice B – For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: PREFERRED TITLING CLASSES

Open to any dog eligible to enter an agility trial as defined in AKC Agility Trial regulations. Dogs may be entered in either Preferred class or the Regular class at any trial. The dog must be entered ONLY in Preferred or Regular classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. So, if you want to enter your dog in Preferred classes on **Saturday**, you must also enter Preferred on **Sunday**.

Novice – All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level regardless of the previous titles. Novice Preferred is NOT split into A and B divisions.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice Preferred or Open Preferred titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent Preferred class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open Preferred title, but have not completed the Excellent Preferred title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have completed the Excellent Preferred title.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: F.A.S.T. – Fifteen and Send Time

The focus of the FAST class at the will be to test the skill, timing and distance work involved in a game of strategy and point accumulation.

Novice A – For persons and dogs that have NEVER acquired an agility title.

Novice B – For dogs that have acquired an agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

Open – For dogs that have acquired the Novice or Open titles, but have not earned a qualifying score in the Excellent class.

Excellent A – For dogs that have acquired the Open title, but have not completed the Excellent title.

Excellent B – For dogs that have acquired the Excellent title.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
