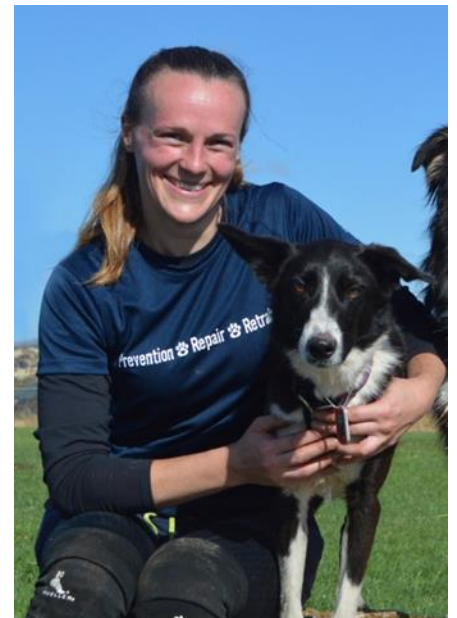
A confirmation notice will be emailed prior to the presentation.

Dr. Carlson graduated from UC Davis School of Veterinary Medicine in 2007 and has been working in small animal practice throughout her ongoing veterinary career.

A local gal: born and raised in El Dorado County and a graduate of El Dorado High School. She participated in 4-H and found a true passion for the animals and their care. In 1994, she became an active participant in dog agility and enthusiastically embraced the sport. Ultimately, she wanted to apply veterinary medicine to dog sports and conditioning.

In 2011, she restored her passion in the sport of dog agility and has been enjoying every moment since. During an agility camp, she had a brief encounter with a veterinarian who specialized in veterinary rehabilitation. This experience rekindled her dreams in sports medicine and rehabilitation, so she set her sights towards furthering her education with over 600 hours of rigorous coursework, hands-on training, and testing: Veterinary Medical Acupuncture at the CuraCore facility in Colorado, Canine Rehabilitation Institute in Colorado, which included a forty hour internship; a portion of that time spent at the Veterinary Orthopedic Sports Medicine Group (VOSM). After her certification in rehabilitation, she continued her education becoming certified in spinal manipulation at the rigorous Healing Oasis Wellness Center in Wisconsin. Additional education included: Botanical Medicine, Aquatic Therapy and Canine Rehabilitation. She is a member of College of Animal Chiropractors (COAC) and International Veterinary Acupuncture Society (IVAS). In addition to her rehabilitation and sport medicine practice during her off time, Dr. Carlson currently practices standard small animal medicine 4 days a week.
