Tired of paying big bucks for the SAME missed contact?

Does your dog keep missing the weave pole entry?

Here's your chance to FIX some of that!

Plus, its an excellent opportunity to introduce inexperienced dogs to the trial environment in a very friendly way!

Rules to Enter:

- Dogs must be at least 1 year of age
- Dogs must compete in their regulation or preferred jump height
- Any AKC eligible dog may enter. They do not have to be entered in the regular trials at this event nor do they have to be AKC registered yet.
- Dogs may be entered in multiple times in the same class, but a maximum of 3 runs for any one dog
- A jump height card is not required nor are the dogs required to be measured.

Entry Fees:

Pre-entry: \$5.00 per run

Opening date for pre-entries is August 1, 2008, 8:00 am

Pre-entries must be received by November 20, 2008; 6:00 pm

Day of Match entry: \$8.00 per run (accepted only if limit of 100 runs has not been met with pre entries)

Exhibitor Rules:

- Toys & clickers are allowed in the ring
- Food is NOT allowed in the ring
- Maximum course time will be strictly enforced.
- No harsh verbal or physical corrections allowed
- Excusal for dog fouling the ring

General Info:

- Classes offered: Novice, Open, Excellent
- No scoring or ribbons/prizes offered
- Match will begin 30 minutes following the conclusion of judging
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or leaser of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
