**DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITES**

Tracks will be run at Cosumnes River College, 8401 Center Parkway, Sacramento and at American River College, 4700 College Oak Drive, Sacramento. The draw and at least two tracks will be run at Cosumnes River College. The remaining tracks will be run at American River College

Cosumnes River College - From Highway 99 south, exit the Cosumnes River College Boulevard exit and go west. Turn left on Bruceville Road. The college will be on your right (high levees surround the entire campus) and enter at the first entrance to the college on your right. At the front of the school, turn right into parking lot #F. Test headquarters will be on the campus in the Career & Technology building courtyard.

American River College - Exit the CRC campus to Bruceville Road. Turn right on Cosumnes River College Boulevard. Get on the Highway 99 freeway going north to Sacramento. Highway 99 will merge into Highway Business 80. Exit Madison Avenue and go right on Madison. Turn right on College Oak Drive. Turn left at the stoplight before the stadium area of American River College and proceed to Ranch House parking lot across from the tennis courts. Campus maps and driving directions will be sent with the judging program for this test.

Closing Date: Entries accepted until Wednesday, November 23, 2011 at 6:00pm, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted. All entries must be delivered to Mary Roseberry, 4553 Stoney Way, Carmichael, CA 95608. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

The Draw: A random drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Wednesday, November 23, 2011 at 6:15pm at Taco Bell, 4041 Manzanita Ave, Carmichael, CA 95608. The first five (5) entrants drawn will be in the test. The remaining will be placed on an alternate list in the order drawn.

Notification: Notification of draw results will be made as soon as possible after the draw for entries via e-mail, if provided, and US mail. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, contact the Test Secretary.

Draw for Running Order: All entrants must be at Cosumnes River College, 8401 Center Parkway, Sacramento, CA 95823 by 9:30am on test morning, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

SDTC Refund Policy: The entry fee will be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw for running order and an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

Awards: A dark green qualifying rosette will be awarded to each passing dog, along with a frame, photo, and calligraphy map of the passing track.

Bitches in Season may participate in the test. Handlers are asked to park well away from the other vehicles and to notify the secretary that your entered bitch is in season. They will be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. The last track will be for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, there will be a separate draw for these bitches.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to insure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccination is required in the State of California. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Test Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending the test hereby waive any claim for damages against SDTC or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Dogs on Leash: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply may result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site.
