Triple Q is awarded to the dog earning the highest combined scored in Rally Masters, Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B classes; qualifying scores required in all classes. High Combined is awarded to the dog earning the highest combined scored in Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B classes; qualifying scores required in both classes. In the case of multiple dogs having the same combined scores, times from required classes will be added, with lowest combined time being the winner. In the case that there is a tie of combined scores and combined times, the winner will be determined by run-off at the conclusion of Rally judging using the Excellent B course used earlier in the trial. Handlers may have five minutes to re-walk the course.

- Any exhibitor with a bitch entered which comes into season after the close of entries will be refunded the entry fee for each entry for that bitch less a \$5.00 processing fee. Request for refund of entry fees must be provided to the Trial Secretary not less than 30 minutes before the start of the trial.
- -Apart from the exception noted in the paragraph above, entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions or any other act or event beyond the control of the Sacramento Dog Training Club, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refunds of entry fees will be made.

Formal confirmation and judging schedule will be sent by U.S. mail and email if provided on the entry form. Judging schedule will also be posted on www.sacramentodtc.org.
