- If a tie for any prize, any dog not present for run-off will forfeit its right to the prize; no awards will be mailed.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring on time for judging.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.

CLOSING DATE: Wednesday, Dec 29, 2021 at 6:00 PM, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed and must be at the address of the Trial Secretary. No telegraphed, telephoned, faxed, unsigned or incomplete entries will be accepted. Entries, including fees, must be delivered to the address of the Trial Secretary with payment of all entry fees prior to the closing date. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopies of forms without an Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Checks returned by the bank for non-sufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25 collection fee will be added to the amount of each check returned. QQ pin awarded for qualifying RAE leg QQQ pin awarded for qualifier in Masters-Excellent B-Advanced B

Triple Q is awarded to the dog earning the highest combined score in Rally Masters, Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B classes; qualifying scores required in all classes. **High Combined** is awarded to the dog earning the highest combined score in Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B classes; qualifying scores required in both classes. In the case of multiple dogs having the same combined scores, times from required classes will be added, with lowest combined time being the winner. In the case that there is a tie of combined scores and combined times, the winner will be determined by run-off at the conclusion of Rally judging using the Excellent B course used earlier in the trial. Handlers may have five minutes to re-walk the course.

- Any exhibitor with a bitch entered which comes into season after the close of entries will be refunded the entry fee for each entry for that bitch less a \$5.00 processing fee. Request for refund of entry fees must be provided to the Trial Secretary not less than 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

- Apart from the exception noted in the paragraph above, entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions or any other act or event beyond the control of the Sacramento Dog Training Club, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refunds of entry fees will be made.

- **Please type or hand-write neatly on entries.** Acknowledgement of acceptance of entry shall occur approximately one week before the date of the trials. Formal confirmation and judging schedule will be sent by U.S. mail and email if provided on the entry form. Judging schedule will also be posted on www.sacramentodtc.org. If you do not receive a confirmation, contact the trial secretary immediately.

- The SDTC and its Secretary assume no responsibility for incorrect entries. Please verify your information.

- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

- Transfers (Move-Ups) in Obedience and/or Rally will be allowed at these trials as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 16A, AKC Obedience Regulations. The transfer form must be given to the trial secretary a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial but would be appreciated by the Wednesday prior to the trial. (Jan. 12)
