

Test Worker Option: In accordance with AKC regulations, one (1) TDX track will be reserved for test workers who have earned required credits. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test worker is chosen. The remaining workers will automatically be included in the drawing with all other tracking entries received.

Bitches in Season may participate in the test. Handlers are asked to park well away from the other vehicles and to notify the secretary that your entered bitch is in season. They will be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. The last track will be for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, there will be a separate draw for these bitches.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to insure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccination is required in the State of California. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Test Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending the test hereby waive any claim for damages against SDTC or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Closing Date: Entries accepted until Thursday, January 13, 2022 at 4:00pm, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted. All entries must be delivered to Meg Azevedo, 8228 Woods Edge Lane, Elk Grove, CA 95758. Overnight and express mail entries **MUST** specify **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**.

Eligibility: All AKC-Recognized breeds that have earned a TD, TDU, TDX, or VST title are eligible to enter this test. A dog may continue to participate in this

test after it has earned the TDX title. **Priority shall be given to dogs that do not hold an AKC tracking dog excellent title.**

The Draw: A random drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will take place on Thursday, January 13, 2022 at 4:15pm at Carl's Jr., 9664 Bruceville Rd., Elk Grove, CA 95758. The first three (3) entrants drawn will be in the test. The remaining will be placed on an alternate list in the order drawn.

Notification: Notification of draw results will be made as soon as possible after the draw for entries **via e-mail**. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, contact the Test Secretary.

Draw for Running Order: All entrants must be at Mather Regional Park, Rotary Park by 9:45 am on test morning, at which time there will be a draw for running order. Entrants not present at that time will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

SDTC Refund Policy: The entry fee will be refunded to any entrant if the secretary is notified prior to the draw for running order AND an alternate is available to run the track, and for all alternates not given the opportunity to run a track.

Awards: A dark green qualifying rosette will be awarded to each passing dog.

Dogs on Leash: Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply may result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site.

Parking Lot: Requires a daily use fee of \$5.00 per car per day.

Mather Regional Park is a county property and proof of current rabies vaccination for each dog on site is required. In order to protect our right to use the property, respect others using the area and follow all rules in effect, including leash laws.

COVID-19 Best Practices: Our goal is to keep everyone as safe as we can. If any exhibitor is sick, know they have been exposed to COVID-19 or uncomfortable with the precautions SDTC is taking, **do not enter**, and stay home. Our mental and physical well-being is most important at all times. Remember when entering a tracking test, it is done at your own risk. If you have not read the Agreement in your trial entry, you should do so now and be aware of what you are signing.

We will be following the rules and guidelines set forward by our state, county, and local agencies along with CDC and AKC guidelines. Our aim is to keep our judges, volunteers, and exhibitors as safe as possible.

If you have traveled out of the state in the last 14 days, consider staying home. If you have a cough, sore throat, shortness of breath or problems breathing, fever/chills, muscle pain or a loss of taste or smell, STAY HOME! If you have recently been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has symptoms listed above, STAY HOME.

- ❖ In accordance with CDC guidelines: fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear face masks while outdoors. MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR UNVACCINATED PEOPLE. THIS WILL BE AN HONOR SYSTEM—IF YOU ARE VACCINATED, IT WILL BE A PERSONAL CHOICE WHETHER YOU WANT TO WEAR A MASK OR NOT.
- ❖ Masks must be worn over the nose and mouth at all times. Facial netting and masks with vents or valves are **NOT** acceptable facial covering or masks.
- ❖ Wash hands as frequently as possible. **Bring your own hand sanitizer.**
- ❖ Avoid touching dogs that are not yours, as the owner may have kissed their dog.
- ❖ The gallery should practice social distancing guidelines

Tracklayers WILL be handling/scenting the articles. If you are uncomfortable handling the articles, please wear disposable/washable gloves (bring your own gloves).

IMPORTANT 10 Day Rules

1. No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within ten (10) days prior to the date of the event. **AKC Tracking Regulations, April 1, 2019. Revisions to the Tracking Regulations effective January 1, 2021. Pink insert (Chapter 1 - General Regulations, Section 12) is issued as a supplement to the Tracking Regulations amended to April 1, 2019 and approved by the AKC Board of Directors November 10, 2020. Issued November 16, 2020.**
2. People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past ten (10) days, they have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler. The judges will determine the order in which the tracks are run and the number of each track. The judges may modify the draw to meet the requirements of the tracklayer. **AKC Tracking Regulations, April 1, 2019. Revisions to the Tracking Regulations effective January 1, 2021. Pink insert (Chapter 2 – Regulations for Performance and Judging, Section 9) is issued as a supplement to the Tracking Regulations amended to April 1, 2019 and approved by the AKC Board of Directors November 10, 2020. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
