COVID-19

What to expect.

All CDC, State and County guidelines related to COVID-19 will be followed. Your health and safety is of utmost importance. Exhibitors are advised to wash their hands frequently and refrain from toughing their faces, nose, mouth and eyes.

Daily Temperature checks: Per California Governor Guidelines, exhibitors are requested to check their temperatures before leaving for the show. Your temperature will be taken at the show with a touchless thermometer and will be issued a wrist band if your temperature is below 100.3^o F. The wrist band must be worn (on either wrist) while you are on the show grounds.

Masks: Per the California Governor masks are to be worn unless a person is able to maintain a physical distance of 6 feet. This would include Rally course walks, award distribution, approaching the ring table or Secretary table and sitting by the ring watching the dogs. **Masks are required to be worn by all persons attending the trial including judges, ring crew, observers and exhibitors at all times**. The mask MUST cover the nose and mouth and may not be made of a mesh fabric. NOTE: Persons exempt form wearing a mask due to a medical condition must wear a non-restrictive alternative, such as a face shield.

Crating: When possible, crate in your vehicle. When crating in the common area leave a MINIMUM of 6' on all sides of your set up.

Additional ring procedures will be stated in the confirmation letter.

LIMITED CRATING- Please crate in designated areas only and follow instructions from staff

- The SDTC, Inc., its Secretary or Sycamore Lane Kennels assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers or any of their dogs or property or for any injuries to children.
- The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Dogs must be kept on leash or crated except when in the judging ring or the warm-up ring. -
- There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the trial grounds.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under AKC rules are allowed on the trial grounds during trial hours.
- If case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its right to the prize. We are Sorry, but, no awards will be mailed.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring on time for judging.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.

CLOSING DATE: Wednesday, Dec 30, 2020 at 6:00 PM, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed and must be at the address of the Trial Secretary. No telegraphed, telephoned, faxed, unsigned or incomplete entries will be accepted. Entries, including fees, must be delivered to the address of the Trial Secretary with payment of all entry fees prior to the closing date. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopies of forms without an Agreement and Rules on the

reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Checks returned by the bank for non-sufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25 collection fee will be added to the amount of each check returned. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries sent in overnight or priority mail must include box checked: NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED.

- Any exhibitor with a bitch entered which comes into season after the close of entries will be refunded the entry fee for each entry for that bitch less a \$5.00 processing fee. Request for refund of entry fees must be provided to the Trial Secretary not less than 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

-Apart from the exception noted in the paragraph above, entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions or any other act or event beyond the control of the Sacramento Dog Training Club, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refunds of entry fees will be made.

-Please type or hand-write neatly on entries. Acknowledgement of acceptance of entry shall occur approximately one week before the date of the trials. Formal confirmation and judging schedule will be sent by U.S. mail and email if provided on the entry form. Judging schedule will also be posted on <u>www.sacramentodtc.org</u>. If you do not receive a confirmation, contact the trial secretary immediately.

-Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

-Transfers (Move-Ups) in Obedience and/or Rally will be allowed at these trials as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 16A, AKC Obedience Regulations. The transfer form must be given to the trial secretary a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial but would be appreciated by the Wednesday prior to the trial. (Jan. 9)

In the case of multiple dogs having the same combined scores, times from required classes will be added, with lowest combined time being the winner. In the case that there is a tie of combined scores and combined times, the winner will be determined by run-off at the conclusion of Rally judging using the Excellent B course used earlier in the trial. Handlers may have five minutes to re-walk the course.
